CAL FIRE Lifts Burn Restrictions

Susanville - Effective Monday, November 16, 2015 at 8:00 a.m., the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) Lassen-Modoc-Plumas Unit (LMU) will lift restrictions on dooryard debris burning. This means you may burn dooryard debris **without** a permit. Permits will not be required until May 1, 2016. However, you must still contact your local Air Pollution Control District to ensure it's a permissive burn day.

This summer brought devastating wildfires to northern California. Though we recognize the need and convenience of being able to burn yard debris, we urge you to use extreme caution. Never leave your fire unattended. If a debris burn escapes your control you could be held liable.

Unit Chief Dave Junette wishes to extend his appreciation to those residents of Lassen, Modoc and Plumas counties who worked so diligently this summer to be fire safe and encourages families to continue in this manner throughout the winter months.
