Community Wildfire Protection Plan

Residents requested to attend workshop to help develop wildfire protection plan.

Santa Clara County, CA – February 2, 2016 – Santa Clara County Fire Department asks residents to attend a workshop to share local knowledge, propose projects, and offer suggested prioritization for the Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP).

The CWPP is a collaborative approach for reducing wildland fire risks to communities and the environment. The plan will include an analysis of conditions such as fire apparatus access, fuels, topography, and weather.

“The focus will be on the structures that intermingle with wildland vegetation,” said John Justice, Deputy Chief of the Fire Prevention Division. “Once complete, the countywide Community Wildfire Protection Plan will be updated periodically to reflect the current risk communities are threatened with as conditions change.”

Residents throughout the County of Santa Clara are encouraged to attend one of the community workshops being offered in February.
