## **LA Galaxy to Help Firefighters at July Fourth Match Ticket Sales to Benefit California Fire Foundation**

Tickets that are ordered through a special web site created specifically for the match will set aside \$5 for the foundation which helps, firefighters, their families and fire victims.

Firefighters and non-firefighters are encouraged to attend the 7:30 p.m. Fourth of July match at the Home Depot Center in Carson. The match will feature firefighters, exhibits, fire safety demonstrations, flyovers and fire equipment. The match will also include a moment of silence as a remembrance to pay tribute to the firefighters who have died in the line of duty.

The California Fire Foundation was created as a way to recognize the courage of firefighters, and the perseverance and sacrifice of fire victims. Formed in 1987 by California Professional Firefighters, the California Fire Foundation's mandate includes an array of public education and victim assistance projects:

California Firefighters Memorial – Located at the State Capitol in Sacramento.

Firefighter Families -- Special funds to provide emergency assistance to families of firefighters killed in the line of duty.

Victim Assistance -- A resource center to assist victims and families devastated by fire and other major disasters, and organize a special fund to provide emergency assistance to fire victims.

Public Education -- Information about fire safety and the toxic effect of fires and conduct public outreach and education about fires and fire safety.
