## PROCLAMATION SUSPENDING BURNING PERMITS

In the CDF Northern Region

Including all State Responsibility Areas and Local Responsibility Areas under contract to CDF within the following counties:

Alameda, Butte, Colusa, Contra Costa, Del Norte, Glenn, Humboldt, Lake, Lassen, Marin, Mendocino, Modoc, Napa, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Yolo, Yuba.

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Due to the menace of wildfires and their potential to destroy life and property, current and predicted fire weather and other factors, utilizing the authority vested in me by Section 4423.1 of the Public Resources Code, I hereby proclaim:

- **All RESIDENTIAL “DOORYARD” (FORM LE-62) BURNING PERMITS** within State Responsibility Areas and Local Responsibility Areas under contract to CDF in the counties listed above will be **SUSPENDED** beginning 08:00 hours July 1, 2003. Previously issued “Dooryard” permits will no longer be valid.
- Agricultural, forest management, and other industrial-type burning may proceed if a CDF fire official has inspected the area and issued a permit.
- Campfires within organized campgrounds or on private property are allowed if the campfire is maintained in such a manner as to prevent the campfire from spreading to the wildland vegetation.

This suspension will continue in place until formally cancelled by me.

This PROCLAMATION is issued at Santa Rosa, California, this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 2003.
