



Announcement – Chief of Technical Services

I am pleased to announce the appointment of Mike Duggan to Chief of Technical Services, effective March 21, 2016.

Mike began his career with CAL FIRE as an Engineering Student Assistant in Technical Services in April 1990 and worked in that capacity through April 1996. After graduation, he worked in the private sector for a Civil Engineering firm involved in projects spanning private and public sectors, including commercial, office, residential (single and multi-family), government, and public works.

In June 2001, Mike returned to CAL FIRE Technical Services as an Assistant Civil Engineer, where he prepared reports, specifications, and plans for day labor and public works projects. In October 2002, he promoted to Associate Civil Engineer, and in 2008, he was appointed as a Senior Civil Engineer, responsible for providing civil engineering designs and management primarily for construction of the Department's fire stations.

Among his duties with CAL FIRE, Mike has managed the Leaking Underground Storage Tank cleanup at 90 facilities statewide. He also oversees the Department's Energy Sustainability Program and has been the design Civil Engineer on several Minor Capital Outlay projects.

Mike holds a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering from California State University, Sacramento and is a Registered Civil Engineer. He also is a CalOES Safety Assessment Program Inspector, Volunteer Fire Captain, EMT, and Assistant Scoutmaster in Vacaville, California.
