PROCLAMATION SUSPENDING BURNING PERMITS

In the CDF Southern Region

Including all State Responsibility Areas and Local Responsibility Areas under contract to CDF within the following counties:

Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, El Dorado, Fresno, Imperial, Inyo, Kern, Kings, Los Angeles, Orange, Madera, Mariposa, Merced, Mono, Monterey, Riverside, Sacramento, Santa Barbara, San Benito, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Joaquin, San Luis Obispo, Stanislaus, Tulare, Tuolumne, Ventura

Due to the menace of wildfires and their potential to destroy life and property, current and predicted fire weather and other factors, and utilizing the authority vested in me by Section 4423.1 of the Public Resources Code, I hereby proclaim:

- **All RESIDENTIAL “DOORYARD” (FORM LE-62) BURNING PERMITS** within State Responsibility Areas and Local Responsibility Areas under contract to CDF in the counties listed above will be **SUSPENDED** beginning 08:00 hours July 18, 2003. Previously issued “Dooryard” permits will no longer be valid.
- Agricultural, forest management, hazard abatement and other industrial-type burning may proceed if approved by the CDF Unit Chief and a CDF fire official has inspected the area and issued a permit.
- Campfires within organized campgrounds or on private property are allowed if the campfire is maintained in such a manner as to prevent the campfire from spreading to the wildland vegetation.
- The CDF Unit Chief shall have the authority to temporarily lift this suspension from time to time during specific periods of low fire danger.

This suspension will continue in place until formally cancelled by me.
