Current Situation: Fire is burning in a mix of grass, brush, oak and pine trees. Firefighters are working in extreme conditions; high heat, low humidity, with the potential for erratic winds. Firefighters are aggressively utilizing resources to construct containment lines & defend structures.

Evacuation Order: Hell's Delight Canyon @ Black Bart Northeast to Potter Valley.

An evacuation shelter has been set up by the American Red Cross at Eagle Peak Middle School - 8601 W. Road, Redwood Valley, CA.

Road Closures: Black Bart Trail West to Black Bart Trail East. Both Horseshoe Circles @ Potter Valley.
