## MENDOCINO LIGHTNING COMPLEX

**Public Fire Information Number:** 707-467-6426

The Mendocino Lightning Complex has burned approximately 25,000 acres with five percent containment. There are currently 87 active fires. Multiple fires are increasing in size. Resources continue to remain limited due to the fires throughout Northern California, with resources being assigned as they become available. Due to predicted weather conditions and anticipated fire behavior, significant increased threats are a possibility. Further areas may be identified for evacuation warnings.

### Evacuations

Evacuation Warnings have been issued in:

- Montgomery Woods/ Orr Springs Road to Running Springs Road
- Mountain View/ Mile Post 9 Area
- Red Mountain/ Bell Springs from Hwy 101 to 13600 Bell Springs Road
- Chicken Ridge Webber Subdivision
- The Community of Cummings
- Town of Leggett
- De Haven Creek and Howard Creek drainage, north of Westport
- Greenfield Ranch Subdivision

Evacuations Lifted:

- Navarro/ Flynn Creek
- Cherry Creek/ Intersection of Hwy 101 and Hwy 162

## **Road Conditions**

- Orr Springs Road: 900 Block west to Montgomery Woods State Park is closed to all traffic except to local residents, may require escorts. (Fire Department, Law Enforcement and critical incident resources (utility company, CalTrans, County Roads, etc.) are allowed.)
