BUTTE COUNTY

Currently there are no evacuation advisories for the Butte Lightning Complex.

Residents should continue to remain alert and be prepared for evacuations if conditions change. Remain calm and follow all instructions of fire and law enforcement officials. Preservation of life remains the No. 1 priority.

Contact the Red Cross for further evacuation center information at 530-701-2390. The following are two evacuation centers:

Las Plumas High School: 2380 Las Plumas Ave., Oroville, 530-538-2310 (please no small animals).

Animal Evacuation Centers: Contact the Butte County Emergency Operations Center, 530-538-7409.

TRINITY COUNTY

Mandatory Evacuations:

- Hyampom Rd.
- Corral Bottoms Rd.
- Areas of Junction City including: Cooper's Bar Estates, Red Hill Rd., Dutch Creek Rd., Evan's Bar, and Soldier Creek. Residents have been asked to leave through the Dutch Creek Road and out to Highway 299.
- Cedar Flat, Friedrich Road, Corral Bottom Ranch, Haglund Ranch, and the area starting at Manzanita Ranch Road to west of the South Fork of the Trinity River to Big Slide Campground west to the county line and north back up to Manzanita Ranch Road.
- The evacuation center is Weaverville Elementary School, animals may be taken to Weaverville Animal Shelter.

Evacuation Advisories remain in place for the residents of Del Loma, Hawkins Bar, Denny, and Fisher Road from "The Colony" up to the end of the road.

Voluntary Evacuations are in place for Swede Creek/Mountain Subdivision and Trinity Village.

SHASTA COUNTY

Mandatory Evacuations for Whiskey Creek Road north of HWY 299 west and all side streets.

WHISKEYTOWN NATIONAL RECREATION AREA

All lake and shoreline areas are open except the Whiskey Creek arm. Visitors need to check at the Visitor Center to ensure which areas are open and closed.

HUMBOLDT COUNTY

Humboldt County Sherriff issued a mandatory evacuation for 10 residents near Dry Lake.
