CONDITIONS ON ARRIVAL:

This fire was caused by lightning and was one of approximately 721 fires started by a dry lightning storm that moved through Northern California on June 20th and 21st.

OBSERVED FIRE BEHAVIOR/ PROBLEMS AND CONCERNS:

Moderate fire behavior observed with the fire primarily backing downslope. The fire is in steep inaccessible terrain and is burning extremely dry brush and trees.

AREAS UNDER EVACUATION WARNING:

- 5,100 block to 6,100 block of Chowchilla Mountain Road
