**CAL FIRE TEHAMA GLENN UNIT  
THURSDAY, JULY 3, 2008  
7:00 A.M. UPDATE**

**Approximately 41 lightning caused fires began on Saturday, June 21, 2008 within Tehama County.**

**Noble Assist Fire (Tehama County DPA) 5,118 acres  
Containment July 3, 2008 – 1800 hours      Controlled – July 6, 2008- 1800 hours**

**TGU Cal Fire assisting Shasta Trinity National Forest and SHU with fire protection. Fire is around Beegum Peak in steep rocky terrain. Line construction, mop up and patrol.**

**Total acreage of ALL fires – 22,907 acres      Total containment – 90%  
Injuries – 9**

**Committed Resources: 1 helicopter, 2 engines, 8 fire support – total 16 personnel**

**Structures destroyed – 2 Residences – 3 outbuildings**

**Growth Potential – Low      Difficulty of Terrain – High**

**Fire Behavior: Noble Assist Fire will be contained this evening. Two engines will continue to patrol. TGU closely watching fire in Yolla Bolly Wilderness that could cross into Tehama County State protected land. Jesse Sisneros has been assigned as Agency Rep. Another concern is the Cub Complex on the LNF. Fire has potential to reach highway 32 & 36 in Tehama County near Deer Creek Meadows. Many cabins in that area.**
