Minimal fire behavior observed. Strengthening and improving fire lines continues. Fire suppression repair is ongoing. Demobilization of resources is in progress. Yosemite valley should be operating on normal transmission line power. While the transition takes place there could be intermittent power in Yosemite Valley and El Portal.

**Current Threats:** None

**Current Road Closures:** None

**Evacuations:** All evacuation orders and warnings were lifted as of 2200 on 08/02/2008.
