Acreage: 14,500 acres

Containment: 10%

Location: Western Lake County / East Colusa County in the Indian Valley Reservoir/Walker Ridge/Bear Valley areas.

Weather: Weather conditions for today call for winds out of the southwest at 5-10 mph. The high temperature is predicted to be 84-94 degrees. The relative humidity is predicted to be 18-25 percent.

Evacuations: Voluntary evacuations in place on Double Eagle Ranch (25 Structures), Bear Valley Ranch (1 structure) and Wilbur Hot Springs (10 structures).

Estimated Cost to Date: \$982,382
