FOREWORD

The California Public Resources Code directs the State Board of Forestry to designate state and privately-owned forest, watershed, and rangeland as "State Responsibility Area." The department's fire protection mission is to protect natural resources on those lands from damages by wildfire. Land not designated as State Responsibility Area is the protection responsibility of federal or local agencies.

The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection provides direct protection for most State Responsibility Area. The remainder is protected by several agencies and counties under contract with the state. The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection also contracts to provide wildland fire protection on certain federal lands, and also provides contracted life and property protection for numerous local governments.

This annual report is primarily a statistical record of fires and damages on State Responsibility Area, and on other areas which the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection protects under contract.

The Emergency Activity Reporting System became effective July 1, 1989. Fire data is entered into the computer at the fire station level, then forwarded to the ranger unit headquarters via a modem and phone lines for storage in the ranger unit database. A copy of it is then forwarded to Sacramento Headquarters for storage in the state database.

GLOSSARY

CDF

California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection

CONTRACT COUNTY

Counties that protect State Responsibility Area with their fire departments. For providing that protection the counties receive payment from the state, and CDF support and reinforcement as needed for fire suppression. There are six contract counties: Kern, Los Angeles, Marin, Orange, Santa Barbara, and Ventura.

DIRECT PROTECTION

The area protected by an agency with its own fire protection force.

FEDERAL ZONE

The direct protection area Of U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, Department of Defense, and Bureau of Indian Affairs. State Responsibility Area within federal zone is protected by federal agencies. For providing that protection the federal agencies receive payment from the state.

LOCAL ZONE

Area in which there is no State Responsibility Area. In general, this is valley floor and desert land. Fire protection in local zone is provided by local government agencies; such as, cities, counties, and fire districts, or by the CDF under contract to local governments.

LOCAL RESPONSIBILITY FIRE

A fire that did not burn or threaten to burn natural resources.

STATE RESPONSIBILITY AREA (SRA)

The area designated by the State Board of Forestry on which the state assumes financial responsibility for protecting natural resources from damage by fire.

STATE RESPONSIBILITY WILDFIRE

A fire in SRA which burns or threatens to burn natural resources.


STATE ZONE

State Responsibility Area and intermingled islands of federal land protected by the CDF and contract counties. Most federal land in state zone is protected by the CDF under contracts with federal agencies.

WILDFIRE

Contraction of "wildland fire." This term is used by wildland fire protection agencies to indicate a vegetation fire. Wildfire generally replaces such terms as forest fire, brush fire, range fire, and grass fire.



1991 FIRE SEASON SUMMARY

The State of California was faced with the potential for another disastrous year as it entered the fifth year of a record setting drought. The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CDF), was prepared for the worst. Preparations from previous years never actually stopped -- the prevention section was warning the public of the fire potential; the detectors were in place scanning the horizon for the first signs of smoke; and the protection section was staffed to its highest level with the help of additional air and ground support and adequate augmentations for the year.

With all the forces in place, CDF was ready for the worst, but the worst never materialized. The weather was the softening element, for the extreme fire weather never materialized nor did the dry lightning storms. The amount of grasses and other annual fuels were diminished, and the forests were dying from the lack of rain, yet we were able to keep the fires in check with the help of the mild weather and adequate augmentations.

The state was able to keep the fire scarred acreage of 1991 to less than 19% of the 5-year average even though the fire starts were over 84% of the average. The list below displays the large damaging fires of 1991:

The large damaging fires of 1991 were minuscule compared to previous years. Along with the mild fire weather, this can and should be attributed to an increase in preparation, coordination, and staffing.

The 1991 weather wasn't always mild; on October 20th the Tunnel Fire started in the City of Oakland. Being pushed by the hot, dry North winds the fire took 25 lives and consumed 2,900 dwellings and 1,600 acres. CDF played a major role helping the City of Oakland mitigate, manage, and analyze the aftermath of their incident.

CDF has been called out in the past to help manage other agencies large-scale incidents and 1991 was no different. CDF was called on not only to assist the City of Oakland but also to assist the Department of Fish and Game with the management and mitigation of Cantera incident, which was a large hazardous substance spill that stripped the Northern portion of the Sacramento River of its fishery.










NUMBER OF WILDFIRES 1982 -1991




ACRES BURNED 1982 -1991



CDF - DIRECT PROTECTION AREA NUMBER OF WILDFIRES - BY REGION





NUMBER OF FIRES BY MONTH


