FOREWORD

The California Public Resources Code directs the State Board of Forestry to designate state and privately-owned forest, watershed, and rangeland as "State Responsibility Area." The department's fire protection mission is to protect natural resources on those lands from damages by wildfire. Land not designated as State Responsibility Area is the protection responsibility of federal or local agencies.

The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection provides direct protection for most State Responsibility Area. The remainder is protected by several agencies and counties under contract with the state. The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection also contracts to provide wildland fire protection on certain federal lands, and also provides contracted life and property protection for numerous local governments.

This annual report is primarily a statistical record of fires and damages on State Responsibility Area, and on other areas which the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection protects under contract.

The Emergency Activity Reporting System became effective July 1, 1989. Fire data is entered into the computer at the fire station level, then forwarded to the ranger unit headquarters via a modem and phone lines for storage in the ranger unit database. A copy of it is then forwarded to Sacramento Headquarters for storage in the state database.

GLOSSARY

CDF

California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection

CONTRACT COUNTY

Counties that protect State Responsibility Area with their fire departments. For providing that protection the counties receive payment from the state, and CDF support and reinforcement as needed for fire suppression. There are six contract counties: Kern, Los Angeles, Marin, Orange, Santa Barbara, and Ventura.

DIRECT PROTECTION

The area protected by an agency with its own fire protection force.

FEDERAL ZONE

The direct protection area Of U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, Department of Defense, and Bureau of Indian Affairs. State Responsibility Area within federal zone is protected by federal agencies. For providing that protection the federal agencies receive payment from the state.

LOCAL ZONE

Area in which there is no State Responsibility Area. In general, this is valley floor and desert land. Fire protection in local zone is provided by local government agencies; such as, cities, counties, and fire districts, or by the CDF under contract to local governments.

LOCAL RESPONSIBILITY FIRE

A fire that did not burn or threaten to burn natural resources.

STATE RESPONSIBILITY AREA (SRA)

The area designated by the State Board of Forestry on which the state assumes financial responsibility for protecting natural resources from damage by fire.

STATE RESPONSIBILITY WILDFIRE

A fire in SRA which burns or threatens to burn natural resources.

STATE ZONE

State Responsibility Area and intermingled islands of federal land protected by the CDF and contract counties. Most federal land in state zone is protected by the CDF under contracts with federal agencies.

WILDFIRE

Contraction of "wildland fire." This term is used by wildland fire protection agencies to indicate a vegetation fire. Wildfire generally replaces such terms as forest fire, brush fire, range fire, and grass fire.



1993 FIRE SEASON SUMMARY

The State of California was faced with the potential for another disastrous year even though it was not facing another year of drought. With a tremendous amount of damage left throughout the wildlands of California by the six years of drought, CDF as expecting the worst, but it seemed as as though California was going to escape the wrath of large damaging fires for the year until . . . October 26th. The Southern California Santa Ana (foehn) winds reared their ugly head again; like many times in the past, it was late in the year with all the vegetation dried to its lowest moisture of the season and ready to explode. And explode it did leaving Southern California reeling in its wake.

Fire Season 1993 officially came to an end with the closing of Fire Season on December 13, 1993 in the South Sierra Region. CDF handled over 201,000 total incidents in 1993 which is an increase of 3% above 1992 and a 20% increase above the five year average. Of that total CDF responded to 6,988 vegetation fires which is 88% of last year and 96% of the five year average. These fires burned over 122,000 acres in CDF direct protection area. The most significant fires for the year, in CDF's jurisdiction, are listed below.

The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection's goal is to, "on a statewide basis, control 95% of all initial attack fires at less than 10 acres in size, and if the fire escapes initial attack, assemble and organize sufficient resources to implement a suitable strategy to control, contain, or confine the fire within economic limits." CDF did not meet their goal this year. Only 94.4% of the fires were contained to 10 acres or less.









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










NUMBER OF WILDFIRES 1984-1993




ACRES BURNED 1984-1993







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

ACRES BURNED - BY REGION












