FOREWORD

The California Public Resources Code directs the State Board of Forestry to designate state and privately-owned forest, watershed, and rangeland as "State Responsibility Area." The department's fire protection mission is to protect natural resources on those lands from damages by wildfire. Land not designated as State Responsibility Area is the protection responsibility of federal or local agencies.

The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection provides direct protection for most State Responsibility Area. The remainder is protected by several agencies and counties under contract with the state. The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection also contracts to provide wildland fire protection on certain federal lands, and also provides contracted life and property protection for numerous local governments.

This annual report is primarily a statistical record of fires and damages on State Responsibility Area, and on other areas which the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection protects under contract.

The Emergency Activity Reporting System became effective July 1, 1989. Fire data is entered into the computer at the fire station level, then forwarded to the ranger unit headquarters via a modem and phone lines for storage in the ranger unit database. A copy of it is then forwarded to Sacramento Headquarters for storage in the state database.

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GLOSSARY

CDF

California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection

CONTRACT COUNTY

Counties that protect State Responsibility Area with their fire departments. For providing that protection the counties receive payment from the state, and CDF support and reinforcement as needed for fire suppression. There are six contract counties: Kern, Los Angeles, Marin, Orange, Santa Barbara, and Ventura.

DIRECT PROTECTION

The area protected by an agency with its own fire protection force.

FEDERAL ZONE

The direct protection area of U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, Department of Defense, and Bureau of Indian Affairs. State Responsibility Area within federal zone is protected by federal agencies. For providing that protection the federal agencies receive payment from the state.

LOCAL ZONE

Area in which there is no State Responsibility Area. In general, this is valley floor and desert land. Fire protection in local zone is provided by local government agencies; such as, cities, counties, and fire districts, or by the CDF under contract to local governments.

LOCAL RESPONSIBILITY FIRE

A fire that did not burn or threaten to burn natural resources.

STATE RESPONSIBILITY AREA (SRA)

The area designated by the State Board of Forestry on which the state assumes financial responsibility for protecting natural resources from damage by fire.

STATE RESPONSIBILITY WILDFIRE

A fire in SRA which burns or threatens to burn natural resources.

STATE ZONE

State Responsibility Area and intermingled islands of federal land protected by the CDF and contract counties. Most federal land in state zone is protected by the CDF under contracts with federal agencies.



WILDFIRE

Contraction of "wildland fire." This term is used by wildland fire protection agencies to indicate a vegetation fire. Wildfire generally replaces such terms as forest fire, brush fire, range fire, and grass fire.


State Responsibility Areas



1996 FIRE SEASON SUMMARY

The 1996 fire season began early with a 3,500 acre fire in the San Diego Ranger Unit on January 10 and 11. This was followed in April by a period of high winds and warm weather in the Sierra-South Region, where they experienced considerable fire activity, including a 17,000 acre fire in Kings County, a 18,000 acre fire in Fresno County, and 11,000 acre fire in Ventura County.

Fire season officially opened in the San Diego, Riverside and San Bernardino Ranger Units on May 6 with San Luis Obispo declaring fire season on May 20. Significant rainfall in northern and central California delayed the opening of fire season for all Sierra and all Coast-Cascade Ranger Units, with the exception of Humboldt-Del Norte, until June 3. Humboldt-Del Norte was able to postpone the opening of their fire season until June 17.

CDF handled over 275,000 incidents in 1996 which is an increase of 3.5% above last year. Of that total, CDF responded to 7,237 vegetation fires which is 10% above last year, and 4% above the 5-year average. These fires burned over 232,000 acres in CDF direct protection area which is 92% above last year and 94% above the 5-year average.











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NUMBER OF FIRES BY SIZE CLASS STATEWIDE

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







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DOLLAR DAMAGE BY CAUSE





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DOLLAR DAMAGE BY SIZE CLASS







1996 STATEWIDE TOTALS










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CDF DIRECT PROTECTION AREA NUMBER OF WILDFIRES - STATEWIDE




CDF DIRECT PROTECTION AREA NUMBER OF ACRES BURNED - STATEWIDE












NUMBER OF FIRES BY TIME

WILDLAND ARSON ACRES BURNED






