## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project is located adjacent to the community of Big Trees Village in Calaveras County. It is on property owned by the Big Trees Village Homeowners Association; it is approximately 18 acres in size. CAL FIRE hand crews will reduce ladder fuels and concentrations of surface fuels by cutting, piling, burning and/or chipping. Green trees less than 10 inches in diameter at breast height as well as brush will be removed to create a shaded fuel break condition. Dead trees larger than 10 inches in diameter at breast height may also be felled as a safety precaution. Target residual stem spacing will be approximately 10 feet between live crowns. Residual trees may be pruned up to 8 feet in height from the ground. The project objective is to improve stand health by increasing growing space for residual trees and to protect homes, maintain evacuation routes and protect natural resources by reducing fuel loading on the Big Trees Village property. Minimal soil disturbance will occur. No activity will take place in watercourse protection zones and there will be no stream crossings constructed. No known occurrences or habitat of threatened, rare or endangered species occur in or adjacent to the project area. No activity will take place on any steep pitches over 50% in slope or when soils are saturated.

## REASONS PROJECT IS EXEMPT



CAL FIRE has concluded that no significant environmental impact would occur to aesthetics, agriculture and forestland/timberland, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, land use planning, mineral resources, noise, population and housing, public services, recreation, transportation/traffic, or to utilities and service systems.
