PROJECT DESCRIPTION


The Coalinga FFS Dozer Cover Project involves assembling a three sided metal shed to include a metal roof to house FKU Dozer 4341 when not loaded on the transport. The shed will replace a previous metal shed that was destroyed by wind. Project activities will be limited to the existing 23' X 20' cement pad located within the Coalinga FFS compound. No ground disturbance will occur.

The site location has been reviewed by a Registered Professional Forester for potential environmental impacts. The Department has concluded that no significant environmental impact would occur to aesthetics, agriculture and forestland/timberland, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, land use planning, mineral resources, noise, population and housing, public services, recreation, transportation/traffic, or to utilities and service systems.
