**PROSPECTIVE TIMBER PURCHASER:**

The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection's Jackson Demonstration State Forest will be offering the following timber sale: BEAR GULCH #2 2019 (370 acres), approximately 6,400 MBF (net), on February 26, 2019. The Bear Gulch #2 2019 Timber Sale is located in Township 18 North, Range 16 West, Sections 28, 29, 30, 32 & 33; MDB&M.

Please note that the Timber Sale Agreements are in draft form as CAL FIRE is reviewing them and the existing language may be modified.

***BEAR GULCH #2 2019***

The minimum bid rate per thousand board feet for redwood is \$725.00 and \$40 for Douglas-fir and all other whitewoods (grand fir/western hemlock). Variable retention, Group selection and single tree selection harvests will be implemented. Timber volume within these areas has been estimated by a timber cruise within the boundaries of the variable retention and 2.5 acre groups and a 100 percent tally of trees within trees selected outside of group boundaries and the (single tree) selection. Sale acreage has been determined from the map, and trees identified for harvest have been marked with blue paint within the (single) tree selection, outside of 2.5 acre groups and all WLPZ's, where as harvest trees not marked with paint for retention within 2.5 acre group boundaries and variable retention silviculture areas will be harvested.

The sale area is composed of eight (8) harvest units, making up a total of approximately 370 acres. A copy of the Bear Gulch #2 THP (1-18-151 MEN) is available via the internet:
