Public Tour of Proposed JDSF Harvesting Plan

Ft. Bragg - Jackson Demonstration State Forest (JDSF) staff will lead a public tour of a proposed timber harvest area Saturday, Dec. 6, starting at 12:30 p.m.

The Hare Creek Timber Harvesting Plan area tour will provide members of the public an opportunity to visit the proposed harvest area, learn about the planned selection timber harvest and associated management activity, and allow JDSF staff to gather comments about the plan.

The proposed plan includes the creation of forest stand conditions described in the Forest Management Plan, will provide research and demonstration opportunities, contribute to the local economy, and generate revenue for operation of the JDSF. Maintaining recreational access and opportunity in the area is a high priority.

The tour will start from the paved wide spot at the junction of Highway 20 and Forest Road 440, near Highway 20 mile post marker 5.8. Participants must provide their own transportation, and the tour will be held rain or shine. Most of the tour will occur on foot, so please dress appropriately and be prepared for a moderate hike. The harvesting plan area is located in the Hare Creek watershed, Sections 27, 33 and 34, Township 18N Range 17W, in the vicinity of Forest Road 450.
