TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF JACKSON DEMONSTRATION STATE FOREST MAIN OFFICE

Fort Bragg– California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) Mendocino Unit is alerting the public that the Jackson Demonstration State Forest (JDSF) Fort Bragg office is closing for renovations on Friday, February 13, 2015. The building, located at 802 North Main Street in Fort Bragg, was completed in 1978 and has not undergone extensive renovations since construction. The building closure is necessary to address maintenance issues, infrastructure deficiencies, upgrade mechanical and electrical systems and replace flooring. The office is expected to reopen to the public on Monday, March 16th at 8 a.m., but please be aware both the closure dates and reopening dates are flexible and may be changed as necessary due to the nature of the work being done and availability of materials/staff.
