### Timber Harvest Resumes in Jackson Demonstration State Forest

#### Seasonal Closures Required for Public Safety

**Fort Bragg**– California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) Mendocino Unit advises the resumption of timber harvesting activities on Jackson Demonstration State Forest (JDSF). During this time, specified areas will remain closed to public entry to ensure health and safety. The following is a list of timber sale areas and associated roads affected by the closure:

#### TIMBER SALE AREAS:

Brandon Gulch, Camp 3, Camp 6, Pleiades, North Fork Spur, Parlin Fork, and Dunlap North.

These plans will be harvested utilizing selection silviculture. Some campgrounds in the Camp One area will be closed at various times this season to ensure safety.

#### ROADS and TRAILS:

Portions of: Roads 90, 300, 305, 360, 361, 362, 363, 380, 1000, 330, 310, 210, 211, and 212.

All or portions of trails: Camp One Loop, Trestle Trail, Sherwood Trail.

Some roads and trails will remain closed until timber operations have been completed in the area, while others may be open on weekends. Detailed information on the closures, including a map, is available at the JDSF office in Fort Bragg and will be posted in the Day Use and other prominent areas.
