Outcomes / Action Items:

- Local HHZ designation process continues, with tier 2 process docs currently under review, and hopefully released online in next month or two.
- Carly et al tested out the Tier 2 local designation process for two watersheds in the Rim fire area, helped to develop a rating process to rate watersheds.
- USFS has turned in new set of mortality projects, and these will be posted after the meeting. Still waiting for CAL FIRE and Caltrans. No other new project submittals.
- Wood storage locations have been validated, and Emily will be working on map/layer next week, with a completed product hopefully ready by the next meeting.
- Emily is working with Heather from Public Outreach to develop a seed zone story map, and demonstrated a draft product. It will eventually be available both from the TMTF website and CAL FIRE's Prepare for Bark Beetles website.
- Emily also created a poster explaining the tree mortality and seed zone issues that will be displayed in the Map Gallery at the upcoming ESRI User Conference in July.
- Liz has been working with Angie from the Biomass group to help coordinate updated information on biomass facilities and utilization, which is out of data on the website run by UC Berkeley. Work includes adding BIOMAT/BIORAM and other status information. They have created a spreadsheet that they will share with the group when complete, to help ensure we all use the latest greatest info.
