Outcomes / Action Items:

- Tier 1 has been updated and peer reviewed. Posting of data and maps is being held until Tier 2 can be finished and reviewed. Tier 2 is in process of being updated – expected ETA is next week (approx. January 10). It must be reviewed and then can be posted.
- There are requests from Madera, Amador, El Dorado counties for site suitability analysis of potential temporary wood processing and storage facilities. We all agreed to refer to these as Temporary sites to reduce confusion.
- Matthew Reischman (co-lead of the Regulations working group) has been asked to distribute maps of active storage sites and validate the location and other information before posting on our website and web map viewer.
- There are several versions of the biomass facilities data floating around (UCB/USFS, CAL FIRE and SNC). Mark and Emily will review Biomass facilities data layer and will discuss how to consolidate and coordinate updates for the layer with USFS.
