**Outcomes / Action Items:**

- USFS finalizing data from recent Aerial Detection Survey flights – hopefully available in next few weeks
- Will confirm what ownership reporting will be done
- Smaller subgroup to coordinate periodic release of data summaries – will include Communications staff
- Plan to update HHZ when new tree mortality data is available – hopefully next few weeks
- Currently updating assets that will feed into HHZ
- Request out to counties, utilities and other entities to send any asset data they might have to Kelly
- Kelly to send email about current asset categories and schedule meeting to discuss getting new assets (and potentially tree mortality data)
- PGE to provide hydro areas and other assets – will coordinate with Kelly
- Rod/Dave with SCE to coordinate with Kelly to provide SCE asset data
- Need to determine update schedule or trigger threshold for HHZ – suggested no more than 2-3 times per year or in coordination with big/important tree mortality updates
- Will look further into Planet Labs' Open California imagery to evaluate for potential uses for us
- Will evaluate potential to incorporate CalTrans and county tree mortality data for HHZ updates – thorough evaluation of process and use is needed
- Chris A & Jeff I. to help coordinate outreach to other priority counties not yet involved in this group
- Mortality Project Mapper deploying soon
- Need to determine any sensitivity issues related to release of project data – entities should check and report back from the perspective of their own data
- Will have a separate meeting to discuss Mortality Project Mapper roll-out to users
- Submittal of FEMA application is pending
- FEMA application will need to be updated with new mortality numbers when they are available
- Liz to schedule LiDAR meeting with Scott Conway if there is sufficient interest – contact her if interested
