**Outcomes / Action Items:**

- HHZ Tier 2 update still in progress, hope to complete by Monday's TMTF meeting
- New ADS release on standby awaiting final approvals
- When new ADS is released, it will prompt a new update to HHZ
- CAL FIRE Region reps are continuing to spread the word about the Mortality Project mapper, and we will be following up with entities to try to get data submittals rolling for the next iteration
- Request to add contact information to the working (but not public) version of the Mortality Projects dataset – will evaluate and come back with proposal
- Facts & Figures document going through final reviews, hoping for release at Monday TMTF meeting, then to be made available online
- Local Tier 1 HHZ Designation process has been prototyped, and will be testing with a pilot project in NEU, as well as a non-CALFIRE entity. Jose (EIDorado Co) volunteered.
- Will look into ways to incorporate existing point data entities may have into the Local HHZ process
- The Upper San Juaquin LiDAR/Hyperspectral pilot project went ahead at a lower density b/c inter-agency agreement wasn't made in time. Will try again for an agreement in time for spring 2017.
- Propose small working group with members from both this working group and Forest Health working group to coordinate LiDAR/hyperspectral efforts across the two groups
