SITUATION

Current Situation:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Overnight, firefighters continued to reinforce existing containment lines. Damage assessment teams confirmed that one structure was destroyed during the first night of the Mineral Fire. Firefighters have been challenged with steep and rugged topography. These conditions, along with forecasted temperatures in the upper 90's will continue to challenge firefighters. Our crews are also adjusting to additional in-camp safety modifications which have been implemented due to COVID 19. Incident personnel are expected to adhere to current county, state, and federal recommendations intended to slow the spread of COVID 19.

Hwy 198 from Parsons Road west to the Monterey County line, Monterey/Fresno County line from Hwy 198 north to Coalinga/Los Gatos Creek Road, Los Gatos Creek Road east to Parson/Mud Run Road, Mud Run/Parson Road south to Hwy 198.
