

JACKSON DEMONSTRATION STATE FOREST ADVISORY GROUP (JAG)

The mission of the JAG is to provide advice/recommendations to CAL FIRE and the Board of Forestry regarding issues relevant to the periodic review of the JDSF Management Plan required under Board policy; ongoing implementation issues; and policy matters relevant to JDSF.

MEMBERSHIP APPOINTMENT AND COMPOSITION

The JAG will be composed of a minimum of 6 and up to 13 members chosen for their knowledge and ability to represent the broad public interest. Members are to be appointed by the Director and are subject to approval by the Board.

Members will be selected through an open solicitation and nomination process to be conducted by the Director. This process will include broad public notification of the opportunity to apply to be a member or to nominate others to serve. Appointments shall be for three-year terms with a goal of no more than one-third of the JAG members replaced in any given year.

MEMBERSHIP SOLICITATIONS

Annually, JDSF staff will post a public notification inviting members of the public to apply to be a member or to nominate others to serve on the JAG.

This notification will occur prior to the planned calendar year meetings. If more than one applicant or nomination for the JAG is submitted, then staff will conduct interviews of interested individuals to serve.
