

CATEGORY PLACEMENT: Applicants will be placed in the appropriate category as follows:

Category 0: The applicant has returnee rights to a CAL FIRE Unit.

Category 1: The applicant is considered "fully trained" and has provided an acceptable document showing completion of ALL of the required trainings listed.

Category 2: The applicant is considered "partially trained" and has provided an acceptable document showing completion of at least one of the required trainings, OR the desirable experience listed.

Category 3: The applicant has not provided acceptable documentation for any of the required trainings or desirable experience listed.

REQUIRED TRAININGS

Non-Handcrew FFI positions (i.e. engines, helitack, etc.): Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Qualifications, CAL FIRE Orientation or items from CAL FIRE Orientation listing, AND one of the following options:

Option 1: State Fire Training (SFT) FFI Certificate or SFT Accredited FF I Academy Completion Certificate

Option 2: CAL FIRE 1A & 1B & 1C or NFPA 1001 & 1072 & 1051

Option 3: CAL FIRE Basic AND all items from CAL FIRE 1A & 1B & 1C

Handcrew FFI positions: EMS Qualifications, CAL FIRE Orientation or items from CAL FIRE Orientation listing, AND one of the following options:

Option 1: CAL FIRE 1C or NFPA 1051

Option 2: All items from 1C
